#### **Question 11**

- **1 Thessalonians 4:13-17;** [13] But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope.
- [14] For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.

#### **Ouestion 15b**

Matthew 28:18-20; [18] And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

- [19] Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:
- [20] Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, *even* unto the end of the world. Amen.

### Review John 13:31-14:14

- [13] Ye call me Master and Lord: and ye say well; for so I am.
- [14] If I then, *your* Lord and Master, have washed your feet; ye also ought to wash one another's feet.
- [15] For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you.
- [16] Verily, verily, I say unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord; neither he that is sent greater than he that sent him.
- [17] If ye know these things, happy are ye if ye do them.
- [18] I speak not of you all: I know whom I have chosen: but that the scripture may be fulfilled, He that eateth bread with me hath lifted up his heel against me.
- [19] Now I tell you before it come, that, when it is come to pass, ye may believe that I am *he*.

- [24] Simon Peter therefore beckoned to him, that he should ask who it should be of whom he spake.
- [25] He then lying on Jesus' breast saith unto him, Lord, who is it?
- [26] Jesus answered, He it is, to whom I shall give a sop, when I have dipped *it*. And when he had dipped the sop, he gave *it* to Judas Iscariot, *the son* of Simon.
