## THE STANDARD LESSON RECORD SYSTEM

This system tends to avoid errors. The lessons will be punched as taken and no further record, bill or receipt will be necessary.

This card certifies that Tom Wells

for the number of lessons marked on the reverse and the term percentage is \_\_\_\_\_

The lesson average marked on the reverse is based upon the scale of 100 excellent, 75 good, 50 poor, 25 very poor, and so on. Four of these cards marked 75, or over, entitle the pupil to a certificate, providing no lessons are lost except by protracted illness. Any mark below 75 indicates that the work of the pupil must be improved.

Lessons lost through any cause other than protracted sickness will be charged to the pupil. This custom is universal among all teachers. Whenever possible, pupils desiring lessons at other hours will be accommodated if sufficient notice is given. Kindly be prompt. Time lost by tardiness is accountable to the pupil.

Payments are strictly in advance. This is a universal custom among professional teachers.

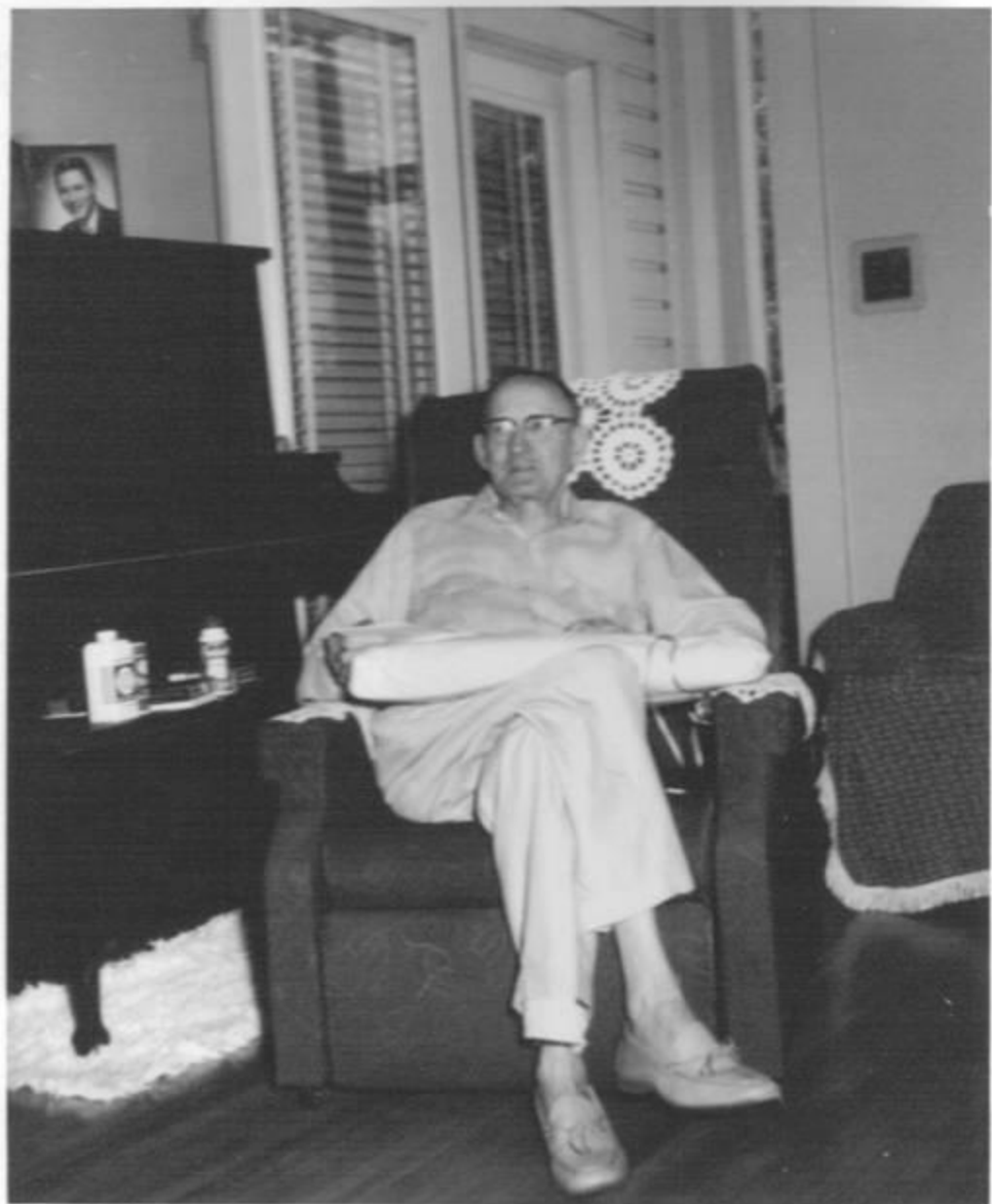


















## Majority for Gurdon Man.

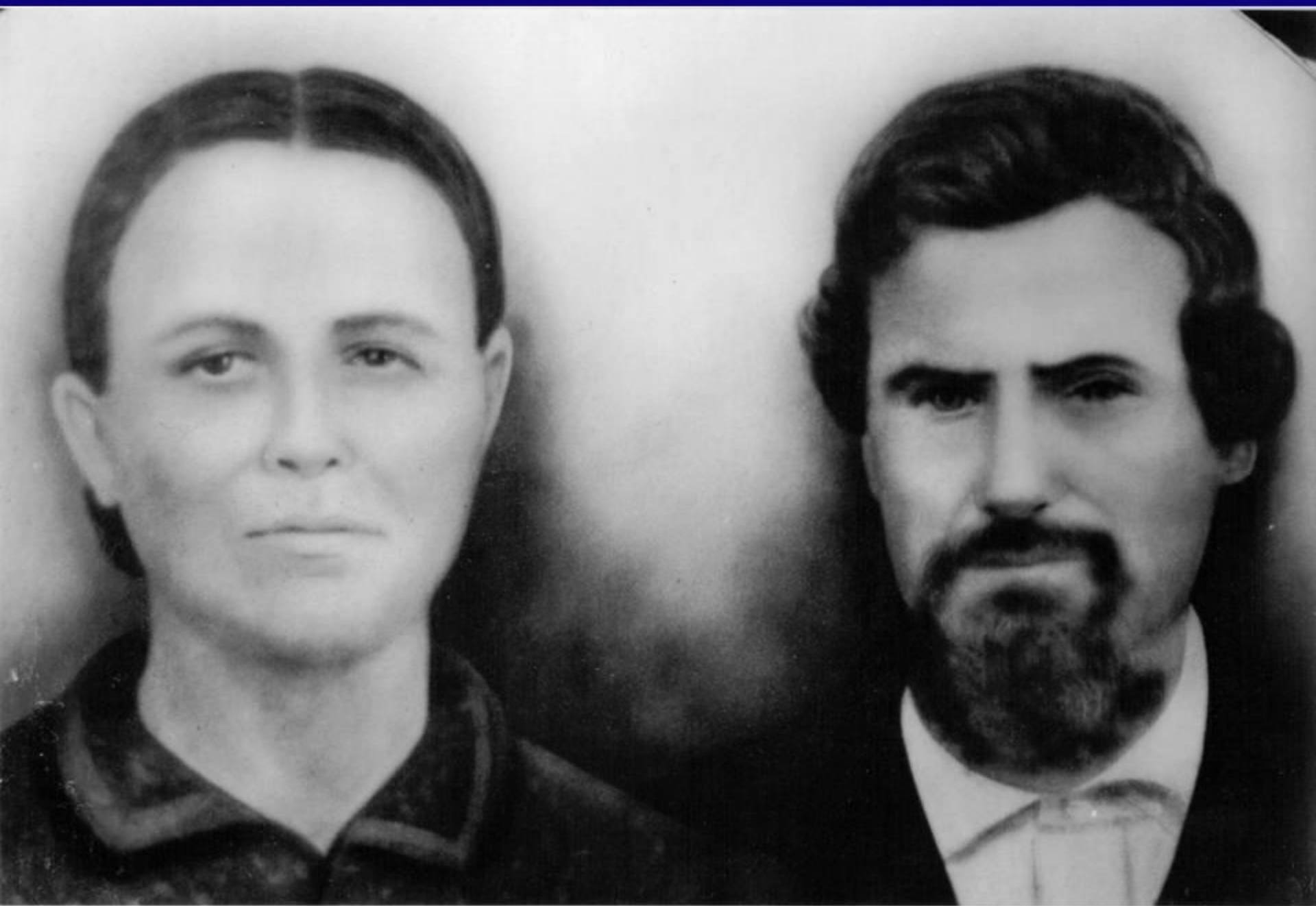














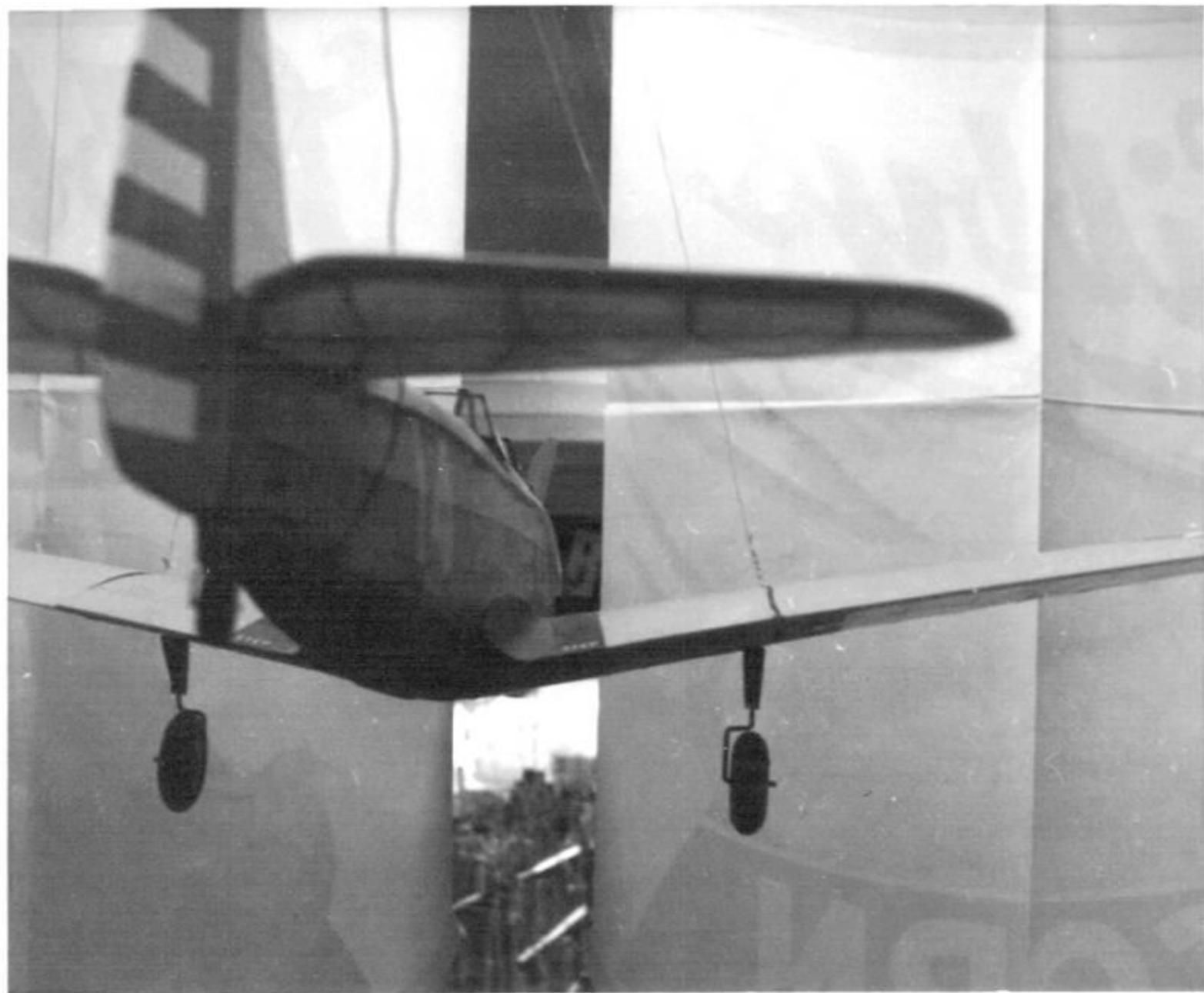
